## RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Roster size is unlimited, however only 10 medals are given per team. Players must be in grade division or lower. Team rosters can only have kids from one school district.
- No AAU teams allowed.
- Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 3 games.
- A maximum of 10 medals will be given to the top 2 teams in each division.
- Team uniforms should be numbered and the same color.
- There will be 2 officials per game, some may be certified but most are volunteers.
- All referee decisions are final.
- Games will consist of two, **14-minute** halves with the clock stopping the last 1 minute of each half. Half time will be 1 minute in length. Overtime will be 1 minute. Second overtime will be sudden death. Game length may change to accommodate the number of teams and games.
- Each team will be allowed two 30-second time-outs per game. Each team allowed only one time-out in overtime.
- The ball will be awarded out-of-bounds on non-shooting fouls until the 7<sup>th</sup> team fouls of each half. Two free throws will be awarded on all fouls from the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul on.
- Zone defense allowed for 6<sup>th</sup> grade only.
- Full-court defense is allowed only in the last minute of each half, unless a team is ahead by 15 points or more.
- A 28.5 size ball will be used.
- Please do not bring your own warm up basketballs. Basketballs will be provided.
- Teams not present within 5 minutes of preceding game will forfeit. **Game times are estimates.** We will play ahead of schedule, so teams are responsible for keeping abreast of time changes. Coaches are asked to please have their team ready to play at their designated times.
- All participants must have waiver signed by coach or parent/guardian. Please present waivers to the check in stand upon arrival.
- Each person is responsible for his or her own valuables.
- Officials and/or Tournament workers reserve the right to alter the schedule because of weather conditions or other conflicts.
- A concession stand will be open for your convenience.
- Coaches should report to the check in stand when they arrive at school.
- All rules not covered above will follow Boy's and Girl's Iowa High School rules.
- Tournament Officials reserve the right to post any rule changes on tournament day. West Fork Schools and tournaments organizers are not responsible for accidents or injuries which may occur on the day of the tournament.
